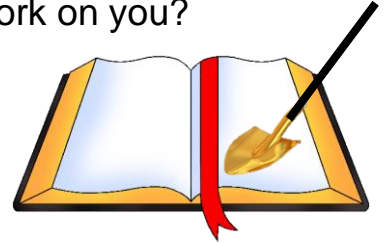




Musing over the message on:
